Innovations Poster Criteria

Each section will be rated on a scale from 0-5 (a score of 5 being excellent) with a maximum total score of 70 points.

1. Quality of the Visual Presentation

- Readability (neat, not crowded, clean font) – up to 5 points
- Flow (panel arrangement and layout are logical) – up to 5 points
- Visual Impact (draws attention, uses graphics) – up to 5 points

2. Sound Conceptual Framework

- Is the goal of the project clearly stated? – up to 5 points
- Are the objectives clearly stated? – up to 5 points
- Is the needs assessment or rationale clear? – up to 5 points
- Is a clear description of the creative solution provided? – up to 5 points
- Is the problem addressed by the creative solution? – up to 5 points
- Are measures that correspond to the objectives reported on? – up to 5 points
- Are the implications of evaluation results clearly stated? – up to 5 points

3. Relevance to Cancer Education / Theme of Conference

- Does the creative solution relate back to a key problem in cancer education? – up to 5 points
- Will the results have an impact on the cancer community? – up to 5 points

4. Responses to Questions, Depth and Breadth of Discussion

- Clarity and depth of project description – up to 5 points
- Insightfulness of responses to questions – up to 5 points
